1. XIV International Congress

Upon arrival at Stockholm-Arlanda International Airport, Stockholm

Stockholm-Arlanda International Airport is located between Uppsala and Stockholm, 36 km south of Uppsala. Tel. +46 8 797 60 00 for general information.

Bus 801 runs between Arlanda and Uppsala city 2 times per hour from about 4 am until midnight. The journey takes about 35 minutes and costs 100 SEK (11 euro). You can buy your ticket from the driver (cash, SEK only).

The main car hire firms have offices in the arrival halls.

Trains leave Arlanda for Uppsala Central Station directly from Sky City.

Frequency: Please consult the timetables online www.resplus.se

Journey time: 15-20 minutes.

Costs 95-150 SEK if purchased in advance. Tickets can be bought from the ticket-collector on board at an additional fee.

Ticket Desk: SJ Resebutik/Travel Office, in Sky City (next to terminal 5).

Taxis leave from outside the arrival halls.

Journey time: about 30 minutes

Cost: about SEK 415. Ask the driver for fixed price in advance. You can pay by credit card or cash.

You can make a reservation in advance at Uppsala Taxi: +46 18 100 000. The cost will be the same, but a driver will be waiting for you in the arrival hall.

Stockholm-Bromma airport is located 9 km west of Stockholm Central Station and 70 km south of Uppsala. The airport bus runs between Bromma airport and Stockholm city bus terminal, next to the Central station.

Frequency: the timetable runs to connect with flight arrivals and departures.

Cost: single ticket about 60 SEK or return ticket about 100 SEK.
Journey time: 15 minutes. Ticket desk in airport arrival hall.

From Stockholm Central Station to Uppsala Central Station:

Frequency: 2 trains per hour from 6 am to 11 pm.

Journey time: 40 minutes.

Cost: about 60 SEK

Tickets are bought from a ticket desk in the main hall of the station or from a ticket-vending machine at the platform.

Stockholm-Skavsta airport is located 110 km south of Stockholm Central Station and 177 km south of Uppsala.

Flight shuttle buses run between Skavsta Airport and Stockholm Central Station.

Frequency: about 30 minutes after every flights arrival. The bus waits for delayed flights.

Journey time: about 80 minutes.

Cost: about 130 SEK single ticket or about 199 SEK return ticket.

Tickets are bought from a ticket desk in the main hall of the airport.

From Stockholm Central Station to Uppsala Central Station.

Frequency: 2 trains per hour from 6 am to 11 pm.

Journey time: 40 minutes. Cost: about 60 SEK.

Tickets are bought from a ticket desk in the main hall of the station or from a ticket-vending machine at the platform.

Västerås airport is located 77 km west of Uppsala. Tel: 021-80 56 10

Bus 941:

Frequency: Bus 941 runs between Västerås Airport and Västerås city centre/Central station.

NB. Since the airport shuttle service is operated by a taxi company, you need to make a reservation in advance, using the “shuttle service phone” in the airport terminal when you arrive.

Journey time: 15 minutes.

Cost: about 20 SEK

From Västerås Central Station to Uppsala Central Station, you can go either by train or by regional bus number 804.

Train: please contact ianls2009@akademikonferens.uu.se for updated time table.

Bus 804:

Frequency: 1-2 buses/hour from 5.20 am to midnight during weekdays and 1 bus/hour during the weekend from 7 am to 2 am.

Journey time: 1 hour and 40 minutes.

Cost: 90 SEK.

Accompanying events

During the Congress an excursion to the Castle of Drottningholm, a church concert, and several receptions will be organized, all of which are included in the congress fee.

Furthermore there will be an optional excursion (Saturday) to the Castle of Skokloster, with lunch included.

Please note: registration for the optional excursion will close on 30 April, 2009. The banquet on Friday, 7 August in the Hall of State at the Castle will consist of a three-course meal, including wine, soft drinks, and coffee (price: 400 SEK [40 €]). A place at the banquet can be guaranteed only for those booking before 30 April, 2009!

Congress Fees

The fees have been set by the Executive Committee at 950 SEK (€ 95,-) if paid before 31 March 2009, and 1150 SEK (€ 115,-) if paid after that date (see booking form here: <http://www-conference.slu.se/ianls2009/registration.html>).

In order to encourage research students to attend, the Executive Committee has agreed to a special rate of 450 SEK (€ 45,-) for registered research students who do not hold an institutional post. These amounts include the receptions, coffee breaks, and the excursion to Drottningholm Castle. The congress dinner as well as the Skokloster excursion (Saturday) have to be booked and paid for individually.

- (2) We would like to remind all speakers that the length of the papers cannot exceed twenty minutes (which would normally correspond to a manuscript of not more than eight double-spaced pages). Considering the fact that the participants come from a variety of countries, the papers must be read slowly and distinctly.
- (3) The rules of the IANLS stipulate that for papers to be included in the *Acta*, they must be read by their authors, and not by someone else.
- (4) If for whatever reason you have to withdraw from the Congress, please inform the Organizing Committee as soon as possible, to avoid last-minute disruptions.

3. Subscriptions to the IANLS

In accordance with the statutes of the IANLS, no one may give a paper without being a member in good standing of the Association. This means having paid the subscription for the years 2006 – 2009. The subscription amounts to the equivalent of € 35,- for regular membership, € 17,50 for reduced membership (students, members in post at an institution for under five years, retired members, spouses, and children of members who do not themselves hold an institutional office). If you have not paid your subscription, please contact the Treasurer or the national coordinators.

Method of payment

During the last Business Meeting at the IANLS Congress in Budapest (August 2006) it was proposed to centralize the financial organization and to use new technology in order facilitate all banking transactions, yet without imposing this system on those who do not want to use electronic means of payment. It goes without saying that we strongly recommend the simple electronic way of paying centrally or payment by bank transfer directly to the account of the treasurer of IANLS.

For this reason you can chose between three systems:

1) Electronic payment by PayPal® (see their website www.paypal.com). Please send, via their websystem, the amount due (37 euros, made up of 35 euros subscription fee plus 2 euros to cover PayPal charges) to jan.papy@arts.kuleuven.be. This method may be preferable for members who cannot make international money transfers without incurring banking charges.
